

FINE WINES FROM BURGUNDY

DOMAINE BRUNO CLAIR

Corton Charlemagne Grand Cru

Corton-Charlemagne Grand cru 0,3361 ha - 0.83 acres

We cultivate plots planted in 1972 and 1976, almost adjacent, located in the upper part of this vast Grand cru slope which spreads over the territory of three communes: Pernand-Vergelesses, Aloxe-Corton and Ladoix-Serrigny. Our plots are ideally located on Aloxe-Corton commune.

The characteristic of this wine lies in the unique capacity to combine good maturity and acidity. This high-class wine exhibits elegance, minerality and power. Always a wine to keep, it requires 5 to 7 years of ageing to reach the aromatic complexity worthy of a Grand cru.
