

FINE WINES FROM BURGUNDY

DOMAINE BRUNO CLAIR

Morey St-Denis rouge En la rue de Vergy

Morey St-Denis En la rue de Vergy, 0,645 ha

Located just above the les Bonnes-Mares, this plot presents a remarkable pedology: the soil is non-existent. The vines are planted directly on the calcareous bedrock and do very well there; they manage to find crevices between the stones and the rock strata to deeply plunge the roots in search of water and nutrients. A part, 0,64 ha - 1.58 acres, was planted in pinot noir in 1980 and the rest of the plot, 0,51 ha - 1.26 acres, planted in 1981 with chardonnay.



In this soil, the pinot noir produces a red wine with a character opposed to the white wine: acidity is regularly low, which gives a more tender wine, round, silky and as opposed to what one could believe is a wine of excellent ageing potential
