One of the oldest winegrowing families in the Beaujolais, "Les Vins Georges Duboeuf" was formed through the passion of a lifetime with wine by Georges Duboeuf. **palate** Pleasant, tender, light, very fruity. Always keeps the signature Gamay taste as well as the taste of fresh grapes.
