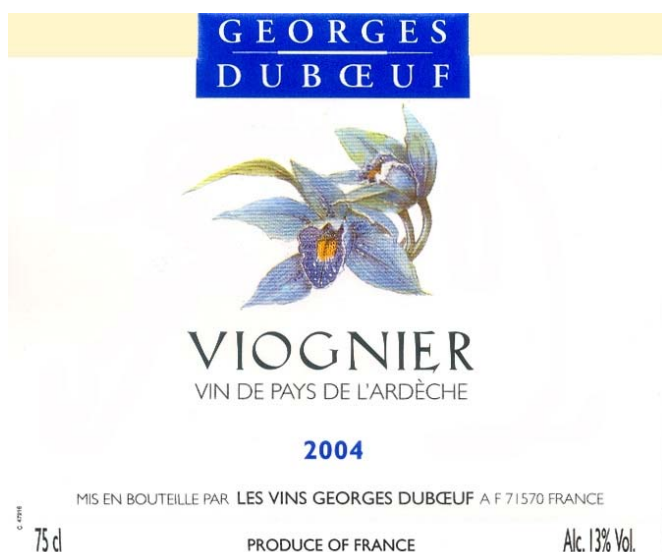
VIOGNIER

Up until the 1980's, the traditional grape variety of the Rhône Valley - Viognier - was only found in the appellation of Condrieu and Château Grillet.

However it has now been planted further south and in particular in the Ardèche. We are in partnership with a group of growers here, planting about 370 acres (150 hectares) adhering to regulations, which ensure that this project will result in wines of high quality. These regulations also cover the methods of vinification and maturing of the wines.

The anticipated yields are in the region of 2.5-3 t/acre (31/40 hectoliters per hectare) maximum, which will enable us to make wines which show a great deal of character.

The wine has a lovely golden yellow color with aromas which are complex and full of freshness. It is evocative of fruits such as peach, apricot, pear and exotic fruits as well as flowers and spices.



TECHNICAL INFORMATION

TASTING:

Although it is a dry white wine it is at the same time rich and full, soft on the palate with the typical flavors of this grape variety.

Nose: Complex with mineral notes, with ripe peach and grapefruit aromas, lemon, blue bonnets and anis.

Palate: fresh and mineral

It has a good balance and a very elegant finish.
