Not only is this wine among the greatest dry white wines in France when it is young, it also has outstanding ageing potential, gradually developing a multi-faceted elegance, which reflects the quality of the vintage as well as its unique origins and method of production.

TASTING NOTES

The colour is a pale, golden-yellow with lovely, brilliant highlights.

On agitation, the intense bouquet, featuring white peaches, linden blossom, and boxwood, reveals toasty and mineral overtones. The aromas develop on aeration in the glass, while retaining all their initial intensity, making this an unusually complex wine.

The lively initial impression on the palate quickly gives way to remarkable softness. This superbly powerful, yet subtly restrained, wine is tremendously mouthfilling and a barely-perceptible sweetness rounds out the inimitable “Y” character.
