Drawing on 160 years of local wine wisdom, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing is used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the vines.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Colour: Medium depth crimson with purple hues.

Nose: Blueberries and Blackberries with hints of vanilla, cedar and chocolate.

Palate: Juicy fruits flow onto the generous palate with a lovely fine and balanced soft tannin finish.
