## 2007 BAROSSA VALLEY SHIRAZ

Family owned and operated, Barossa Earthworks make their wines from 100% Barossa grapes produced by small Barossa family growers. They express the best of the Barossa Valley and are easily shared with food and friends – the essence of wine.

Drawing on 160 years of local wine wisdom, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing is used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the vines.

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

- Colour: Medium depth crimson with purple hues.
- Nose: Lifted, bright, blue fruit and mulberry jump out of the glass with hints of sweet spice and biscuit.
- Palate: Sweet fruit flows onto a medium to full palate and is wonderfully balanced with briar and peppery spice which continues through the long finish. Hints of biscuity French oak mingle with the fruit and fine yet youthfully austere tannins add to the structure and palate weight.
