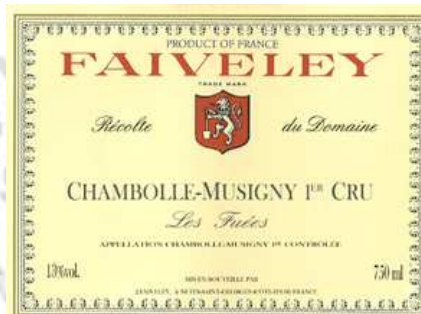


Chambolle-Musigny

The "Fuées" is a Burgundian term indicating the extent of vines a man can plough in a day with a hoe.

The wines of Chambolle are remarkably gentle and powerful; without doubt the most balanced wines of Burgundy.
