### 2010 Tasmanian Wine Show

Freycinet Vineyard and Winery on the Tasmanian East Coast had a very successful showing at the recent 2010 Tasmanian Wine Show held on 11 to 15 January in Launceston. The Annual Tasmanian Wine Show is fortunate to have **James Halliday** and **Huon Hooke** as regular members of the judging panel. James Halliday, the highly acclaimed and widely respected wine judge and author, is the panel chairman and Huon Hooke is the *Sydney Morning Herald* wine writer and a contributing editor for *Gourmet Traveller Wine* and a regular contributor to *World of Fine Wine* and *Decanter*.

Freycinet Vineyard and Winery won 7 medals: 4 Gold and 3 Silver - across the full range: Riesling, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and the Chardonnay Pinot Noir Sparkling. The 2007 Freycinet "Louis" Pinot Noir won **Top Gold** and the **Winemaking Tasmania Trophy** for the best 3 year-old Pinot Noir at the Show.

The 2010 Tasmanian Wine Show confirms the skills of Freycinet's renowned vigneron Claudio Radenti. Claudio manages the growing of the grapes and the wine fermentation and has secured Gold and Silver awards across four wine types – a rare distinction. Commenting on the awards, Claudio said:

"The judges' assessments are very pleasing and acknowledge the efforts of all members of our dedicated team who pay great attention to detail right through the process from vine tending, grape picking, wine fermenting and bottling. It was particularly pleasing to have both of our Pinots awarded Gold. The 2007 year was a very good season producing reduced yields and very favourable ripening conditions that have resulted in some of our richest pinots ever".
