2007 Cravens Place Shiraz



Winemaking:

This wine is created to be approachable and enjoyable whilst young, with the typical flavours, structure and tannin one comes to expect from a Heathcote Shiraz. The 2007 shows the intensity in flavours and structure this vintage created.

Harvested from two vineyards in Heathcote: Ellis Vineyard and Wildena Estate; the wine spent up to 13 months in American and French oak.

Wine Analysis:

Alc/Vol: 14.3% Acidity: 6.42 g L-1 pH: 3.51

Tasting Notes:

Colour: Bright ruby red

Nose: Herbal notes, dark cherries and dusty oak aromas are present

Palate: Medium weight, the wine is smooth with integrated tannins and great length of flavour. The aromas of herbs, dark cherries and oak follow though to the palate, with an intense mocha flavour adding further complexity

Cellaring: This wine may be enjoyed now, or be cellared in the short term
