

# KOORYONG

## 2007 CLONALE BY KOORYONG

---

<b>VINEYARD</b>	Kooyong is located on the Mornington Peninsula at Tuerong and focuses on producing Pinot Noir and Chardonnay wine; which are both suited to the Peninsula's cool maritime climate.
<b>VINTAGE</b>	The 2007 vintage was one of the earliest on record. The vintage was similar to 2006, but with lower yields. Overall it was a good vintage, resulting in well structured wines.
<b>VITICULTURE</b>	Estate grown fruit is now supplemented by specially selected purchased parcels of fruit. The trellis type is Vertical Shoot Position (VSP).
<b>WINEMAKING</b>	Whole bunch pressed and barrel fermented naturally without inoculation. Matured for 10 months in French oak (15% new)
<b>ALCOHOL</b>	13.0% vol
<b>COLOR</b>	Vibrant pale straw colour with a tinge of green
<b>BOUQUET</b>	Lemon barley aromas supported by citrus fruit and white floral overtones.
<b>PALATE</b>	Lemon curd and grape fruit flavours, a linear palate supported by vibrant acidity.
<b>CELLARING</b>	With careful cellaring, this wine has good potential for ageing.
