## 2008 BAROSSA VALLEY SHIRAZ

Family owned and operated, Barossa Earthworks make their wines from 100% Barossa grapes produced by small Barossa family growers. They express the best of the Barossa Valley and are easily shared with food and friends – the essence of wine.

Drawing on 160 years of local wine wisdom, traditional winemaking methods and minimal processing is used to preserve the purity, integrity, texture and flavour of the vines.

## WINEMAKER'S NOTES

- Colour: Dense crimson purple.
- Nose: Ripe dark cherries, summer pudding and blackberry jam with hints of cinnamon and vanilla.
- Palate: Rich and juicy with flavours of wild blackberries and black forest cake. The tannins are ripe and generous, while the finish is fresh, lingering and leaves the impression of ripe summer berries.
