- The Langmeil property was first founded in 1841 by a pioneering settler Christian Auricht formally from Prussia. He left after being persecuted for his religious beliefs, and fled to the Barossa for religious freedom.

- Langmeil Winery is believed to have the oldest known surviving Shiraz vineyard in Australia, and probably the world. Planted way back in 1843 by Christian Auricht and known as the Langmeil Freedom Vineyard.

- The Langmeil property had been abandoned since the mid 1980's and it was not until 1996 when three mates and their families, Richard Lindner, Chris Bitter and Carl Lindner all fourth and fifth generational Barossans started to reinvigorate life into this old historic property. Since then they have brought the property back to and surpassed its previous halcyon days.



- Langmeil Winery mainly focuses on premium red wine production and is dedicated to 100% premium Barossa wines.



- Langmeil continues to be acclaimed both nationally and internationally for producing some of the best of the Barossa and represents wines from \$20 to \$100 retail. Their Flagship wine being the 1843 Single Vineyard Shiraz; The Freedom.

- James Halliday one of the premier Australian wine critics and producer of the famed Australian Wine Companion has consistently rated Langmeil as a 5 star Winery, the highest possible accolade, placing Langmeil in the top bracket of Australian wineries over the last 4 years.



- Paul Lindner one of the family members, has been one of the shining lights of the young winemakers in the Barossa. Having been involved with vintages in the Barossa since 1993, his knowledge, passion and attention to detail has continued to evolve and with his experience at the helm of Langmeil's winemaking has steered them to; True Winemakers Wines.

- Langmeil's team covers a broad range of previous experience in the wine industry, which includes Grape Growing, Winemaking, Marketing, Sales and Management. In fact the team at Langmeil Winery have all worked in the world of wine, especially for other leading Australian producers such as Orlando, Seppelts, St Halletts, Rockford, Wirra Wirra, d'Arenberg, Chain of Ponds and Yalumba
